



If a school has reason to believe that a student may need accommodations in order to receive a commensurate education because of a disability as defined under Section 504, then the student must be evaluated. The evaluation must be sufficient to determine whether or not the student is disabled. If the evaluation reveals that a student is disabled, the school should proceed to the next step of the analysis.
